Endings are hard. I had an old preacher in seminary who said that in the average 3-year appointment, you spend your first year getting to know people. You spend your second year and half of your third year preaching good sermons, giving good counsel, and leading your congregation well. The last six months that you have is when you watch the congregation disconnect from you

as they begin to anticipate the appointment of a new pastor. I've been appointed here for four years, and I hope that means that you got to hear two and half years of good sermons, have received good counsel, and I hope I've led you well so far. I know that now I am very near the end of tenure as the Sr. Pastor of Church Street UMC. Even so, I feel that I still have some wisdom to share, and so I would invite you to read on that we all might "... press on toward the goal for the prize of the heavenly call of God in Christ Jesus" (Philippians 3:14).

Each and every pastor in the United Methodist Church is appointed for 1 year at a time. So, since I've been serving Church Street UMC for 4 years I've been appointed here 4 times. The only elder that serves more than 1 year at a time is the Bishop who serves for a quadrennium (or 4-year term). This June, Diane will begin her first 1-year term. As Diane prepares for you, and as you prepare for her, let me encourage you to do 2 things. 2 Things that I know are already in the DNA of Church Street UMC.

First, pray for her. Moving is never easy. Moving to a new place with new faces that will know you within a couple of weeks that you won't know is difficult. The learning curve for pastors in new appointments is steep. Not to mention the fact that she has to try to explain the unexplainable—the ineffable every week. Diane will need your prayers. She will be praying for you. She needs you to do the same for her.

Second, Diane needs to experience the hospitality that CSUMC can offer. Church Street UMC has been one of the most hospitable churches I have ever been a part of. We have acted like a family and we have stuck with one another. If I need someone in any of 100 different arenas, I can call someone at our church who can take care of it personally, or they can direct me to the person/group who can. Be as hospitable to Diane as you have been to me and she will be able to attest to the incredible nature of your hospitality too!

That's it. That's the wisdom I'll leave you with. Pray for your pastor. Be hospitable to her. I have a feeling though, that if you do those two things that this will be an amazing appointment both for Diane and for Church Street UMC!


