LIGHTING THE PEACE CANDLE Daniel Lovelady  
Leader: This is the second Sunday in Advent. Today, we light another purple candle. The first Sunday, we lit the candle of hope. Today, we light the candle of peace. Our world is not always a peaceful world. People hurt other people. Countries are at war today. People don’t take care of the world. People yell and scream at other people. But God promises peace. During Advent, we pray that we, as well as all people, will seek God’s peace.  
Congregation: When we look at the second candle, we remember God’s promise of peace. We recall the words of Jesus in John 14:27, “Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you.” In times of war and hatred, it’s hard to remember that Jesus is the one who brings peace.
